Great Lakes Region Burn Mass Casualty Incident (BMCI) Response Plan

The American Burn Association (ABA) - designated Great Lakes Region¹ encompasses Burn Centers (BC) located in Michigan, Indiana, and Ohio

- For a BMCI occurring anywhere within the Great Lakes region of the United States, the State of Michigan Burn Coordinating Center (MBCC) in collaboration with ABA regional coordinators serve as the communication and coordination center to support Burn Center(s) with burn bed census and/ or patient triage and transfer
- A BMCI is defined as any incident where capacity and capability significantly compromises patient care, as identified in accordance with individual BC(s), state, regional or federal disaster response plans

Requesting Assistance from the MBCC for BMCI Response and Coordination

Upon request by a referring BC(s) the regional coordinator(s) in collaboration with the MBCC

- Conducts a bed census of Great Lakes region Burn Centers
- Supports and assists with regional efforts for patient triage and transfer

Agencies requesting assistance include:

- Michigan, Indiana & Ohio BCs
- Regional Disaster Coalitions
- Affected ABA BCs
- Any affected state or regional hospitals
- ABA Regional Coordinator(s)
- ABA Central Office

Upon notification MBCC in collaboration with the ABA regional coordinators:

- Conducts burn bed census of nonaffected Great Lakes region burn centers
- Coordinates requests for patient transfer between referring and receiving BC(s)
- Monitors patient flow within Great Lakes Region.
